QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS No. 12

Regarding the request for clarification of tender documents for the procurement no. NZN/03/14 - Performing construction, reconstruction and renovation works on the school buildings within School Modernisation Programme, we submit the following answers:

1. BIDDER'S QUESTION:

On the question of a potential Bidder - In the event that a Bidder submits offer for more than one party, whether general documents such as registration, solvency report etc. have to be submitted within a Bid for each LOT or it is sufficient to submit within a Bid for only one LOT – you answered that all documents must be submitted within a Bid for each LOT.

We plan to submit a Bid for each LOT, does that mean that we have separately to submit for each LOT:

- photocopy of the employment booklet and Form M3 for all 120 employees (4 times)
- Orderers' conformations, or final certificate of payment or contracts for similar facilities (4 times)
- Licences and CV for all engineers (4 times)

Or whether is your answer related to the general documentation (Bon-1, scoring, confirmation of insolvency, Excerpt from Business Registry Agency -BRA)?

ORDERER'S ANSWER:

Public procurement is divided into lots. Each lot will form a separate contract. The Bid represents an integral part of the contract, so all documents must be submitted within the bid for each lot.

2. BIDDER'S QUESTION:

In the tender documentation, on the page 26/83 - 2.3 Information for qualification/1. Experience/b. Particular - Experience in the performance of works, as a leading contractor, for at least five (5) facilities of a similar nature and / or complexity as proposed contract - construction, reconstruction, upgrading, adaptation and rehabilitation of public facilities (school buildings, commercial, administrative buildings, university buildings, hospitals, museums and libraries as well as buildings for cultural and artistic activities). Whether is acceptable by Orderer experience in the performance of works on facilities – dormitories and preschool facilities?

ORDERER'S ANSWER:

The answer is yes.
