1	N/A	<p>Questions dated: 18/08/2015</p> <p>In Lot 1 is a lot of equipment that is in its purpose very diverse. This way conceived LOT is almost impossible to offer and at the same time to fulfill all the required specifications. We believe that the objective of the contracting authority is to purchase the equipment, that was required by various scientific institutions in the country, at the best price, but from the experience of our European colleagues and with the previous tenders for capital equipment experience, we can say that LOT written in a such way is likely to be cancelled due to unfulfilled desired characteristics or because of exceeded the estimated value. Also it is unclear why the individual pieces of equipment, even though the same or similar characteristics to equipment in Lot 1, are separated into separate LOTS (e.g, Lot 22, Lot 34,...).</p> <p>For all these reasons we ask you to divide LOT 1 into a few LOTS which will contain the equipment of the same or similar purposes such as. Spectrophotometers; Thermal imaging and infrared cameras; Microscopic cameras, microscopic software and microscopes; A video processor (which is, in contrast to the narrow band filters for astronomy, intended to visualize the inside of the human or animal body when performing laparoscopic procedures); Filters for astronomy etc.</p> <p>This will enable the bidders, who would not be able to offer a complete LOT 1 in the form such is now, to be involved in the tender process, which will certainly increase competition and likely to affect that offered prices are lower.</p>	<p>Lots are already defined and there is no possibility to change them.</p>

		We kindly ask you to consider extension of the deadline for submitting the offers for at least 45 days, and to alter the tender documentation accordingly, for the following reason:	
2	N/A	<p>Some of the lots are very large and technically very complex, with more than 100 of requested positions; for example, lot 2 consists of 123 positions, each of them is a technically very sophisticated electronic unit, with lot of specifications, options etc. There are more than 50 different manufacturers, and with every one of them bidder must negotiate all aspects of offer, including price, technical compliance, authorisation, installation and training, after-sales support etc.</p> <p>It is impossible to conduct such complex task in short timeframe, especially having in mind that there is a summer holiday closure in many companies and manufacturers. Only when the offer is complete, we can apply for a bank guarantee for a defined amount.</p> <p>For that reason, we ask you to extend the deadline for submission of offers for at least 45 days (at least for the larger lots 1-11). This would significantly increase chances that you get complete and competitive offers for all lots.</p> <p>Please clarify: Lot 5.33 — Safety cabinet</p> <p>There is missing dimensions.
