10	Page 65, Bidding Documents	In the requests regarding the technical specification (p. 65) the Purchaser defined the following term: "In case of products, to which an expiry date is assigned by the manufacturer, the supplier is required to deliver to the end user products with the expiry date which must be no less than 70% of the total time that elapses between moment when the product is made and the expiration date assigned by the manufacturer." Regarding the stated requests, as the exclusive distributer of the goods from the stated lot for the territory of the Republic of Serbia, we inform you that there are objective circumstances which make the fulfillment of this request regarding the expiration date impossible, because certain goods – reagents have a total manufacturer's expiry date around 3 to 6 months, they have to be imported, which means that they have to go through the following stages: controls in the country of manufacture, packaging, export, transport to the country where they are being sold, warehousing and finally the distribution to end users. Therefore this process can, objectively, last a number of months.	Upon the signing of the contract together with consent and statement of the end user, with justified objective reasons, it is possible to change the percentage of the total time of the expiration date.

	Having this in mind, it is almost certain that the reagents will, at the moment of delivery have an expiration date which is shorter than the demanded, but not shorter than 40% of total time which past from the moment of production until the expiration date given by the manufacturer.
