With regard to your Request for Clarification regarding tender dossier forprocurement of 302 Packages of Building Material, within the framework of subproject III of the Regional Housing Programme, reference no. RHP-W3-CM/IOP1-2016, we provide the following clarification:

Request for Clarification:

(Filed under number 3549 from 21.June 2017)

1. Tender dossier states that the Bidder must demonstrate possession of certificate for standard OHSAS 18000/2007. Since there is OHSAS 18001/2007, we consider it typo error, and therefore ask you to correct it in order to make bidding documents accurate.

Answer:

With regard to Request for Clarification, dated on 21.06.2017, regarding bussines capacity and required standard OHSAS 18000 (Occupational Health and Safety Assessment Series) – answer has been published on the website of the Contracting Authority, titled "Request for Clarification no.2"

2. We deem that, in addition to related copies of certificates, it is necessary to Anual Compliance Report or Validity Confirmation issued by certification body, demonstrating that certificate is not suspended or terminated prior to the day ofprocurement notice publication. By that means, possible misuse of certificates which are formally valid according to date stated on certificate but without the certainty of its actual status, would be prevented.

Answer:

It is not necessary to submit Annual Compliance Report or Validity Confirmation of certification body on certificate status confirming certificate's validity. Procurement Committee Members will check certificate status during the process of bid evaluation.

3. Is it required to submitt attestations of construction material quality (attests) in the bid, in order to determine compatibility of offered goods with tehnical requirements provided in Anex 1?

Answer:

It is not necessary to submit attestations of construction material quality (attests) within the bid, but it is necessary to provide them during the delivery phase, in order to attest that delivery of quality material and equipment is provided in accordance with the Terms of Reference, which are part of Tender Dossier.
