Pursuant to the Framework Agreement signed between the Council of Europe Development Bank and the Republic of Serbia on Regional Housing Programme dated 25th October 2013, Grant Agreement signed between the Council of Europe Development Bank and the Republic of Serbia on implementation of Third RHP Subproject dated 9th September 2014, Decision on the establishment of a limited liability company for managing of the project Research and Development in Public Sector (Official gazette of RS, No. 51/2010, 72/2013, 24/2014 and 65/2014), and in accordance with CEB Guidelines for procurement of supplies, works and services, Evaluation report number 8490 dated 07.06.2016., the director of „JUP Istraživanje i razvoj” d.o.o Beograd delivers the

DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD

1. In the international open procurement procedure number RHP-W3-AB/IOP1-2015, the subject of which is Construction of buildings in the second phase with related infrastructural inter-block landscaping and equipping of buildings on cadastral parcel 3672/3 KO Ovča, City Municipality of Palilula, Belgrade, Serbia, within the Regional Housing Programme in the Republic of Serbia – third subproject, contract is awarded to tenderer Zlatibor-gradnja Beograd a.d. Požeška 104, 11 000 Belgrade, tender number 6279 dated 05.04.2016.
2. This decision shall be published at the Public Procurement Portal and the website of the Contracting Authority no later than five days from the day of its delivering.

Subject of the procurement: Construction of buildings in the second phase with related infrastructural inter-block landscaping and equipping of buildings on cadastral parcel 3672/3 KO Ovča, City Municipality of Palilula, Belgrade, Serbia

Type of procurement procedure: Open international procedure, initiated pursuant to Decision on launching of the procurement procedure no. 5507, i.e. XXVIII 01 number 031-1150-1/15 dated 21 September 2015.

Estimated procurement value: 7,034,808.00 EUR (or 844,177,000.00 RSD).

Procurement notice, i.e. Public Call and tender documentation have been published on the Contracting Authority website JUP "Istraživanje i razvoj" d.o.o. Beograd (www.piu.rs), provided in the Procurement notice, on the Public Procurement Portal of the Republic of Serbia and in the Official Journal of the European Union on 21 January 2016, with original deadline for submission of applications by 14 March 2016 until 11:00 a.m. Due to modifications in tender dossier, published on 29 February 2016, deadline for submission of applications was extended by 5 April 2016 at 11:00 a.m.

During the Public Call for submission of application, there had been one modification in tender documentation and publication thereof, as well as nine clarifications upon the requests of potential tenderers.

Tender Opening Session was held on the Contracting Authority premises, at JUP "Istraživanje i razvoj" d.o.o. Beograd, Veljka Dugoševića 54, first floor – room for tender opening sessions, and was conducted by the Procurement Committee established based on the Decision on the Establishment of the Procurement Committee for implementation of procurement procedure no. 5508, i.e. XXVIII-01 no. 031-1150-2/15 dated 21 September 2015. The Committee included the following members:

The Procurement Committee (hereinafter referred to as: Committee) composed minutes from the Opening Session no: 6284 dated 5 April 2016, which was handed in to authorized representatives of tenderers upon the completion of the Opening Session, and published on the same day on website of the Contracting Authority JUP "Istraživanje i razvoj" d.o.o. Beograd, www.piu.rs.

The Committee reviewed and evaluated the tenders in the period between 6 April 2016 and 13 May 2016.

Since tendering documentation did not require for submission of certified and signed form of the Integrity Contract, the Committee members unanimously concluded that written request should be sent to all tenderers in the subject procedure, requiring them to submit original copy of certified and signed form of the Integrity Contract. The subject request for clarification was sent to all tenderers on 11 April 2016, specifying the deadline for submission of clarification by 14 April 2016. All tenderers fulfilled the request within the specified deadline.

In the course of review and evaluation of tenders, the Committee established the following:

- 1) Tender submitted by **GPD "Banković" d.o.o. Milentija Popovića bb, Crna Trava**, tender number: **6276** dated **5 April 2016**, with the following data from the tender:

a) Evaluation of administrative compliance

Analyzing the tender and documents submitted thereto, the Committee established that the tender is compliant with administrative requirements/criteria stipulated in tender dossier, Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, item 22.1: *Examination of the administrative compliance of tenders*, concluding the following:

- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 3: *Participation*, items (1) to (3), Article 11: *Content and presentation of tenders* and Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, the tender is complete;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 10: *Language of tenders*, the language of tender is appropriate;
- In compliance with the Request for clarification, the Integrity Contract was signed;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 3: *Participation*, the tenderer has fulfilled all mandatory conditions for qualification, i.e.:
 - Pursuant to Articles 3.1.1. and 3.2.1, the tenderer is registered at the competent authority;
 - Pursuant to Article 3.1.2. and 3.2.2, the tenderer has not been punished for listed criminal offences;
 - Pursuant to Articles 3.1.3. and 3.2.3, the tenderer has paid all due taxes and other liabilities in compliance with regulations of the Republic of Serbia;
 - Pursuant to Articles 3.1.5. and 3.2.5, the tenderer has fulfilled all requirements set forth in relevant legislation pertaining to occupational health and safety, employment and working conditions, environmental protection, and its securities that it holds the rights to intellectual property.

Analyzing the tender and documents submitted thereto, the Committee established that the tender **IS NOT COMPLIANT** with the following administrative conditions/criteria stipulated in tender dossier, Volume 1, Section 1 *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, item 22.1: *Examination of the administrative compliance of tenders*, concluding the following:

- Pursuant to Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderer*, item 12.1.1. and Volume 1, Section 2: *Tender Form Appendix to Tender*, **Tender Form IS NOT adequately filled in;**
- Pursuant to Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderer*, item 12.1.1. and Volume 1, Section 2: *Tender Form Appendix to Tender*, **Tenderer's Declaration IS NOT adequately filled in;**

Reviewing the subject tender, it was concluded that tenderer had submitted:

- *Tender Form* with improperly inserted tender reference number, contract name, place and date.
- *Tenderer's Declaration*, where in item 8 it was not stated whether the tenderer is a consortium or not, although from the rest of documentation it could be concluded that tenderer was applying independently.
- Appendix to Tender for contract on works did not contain duly inserted procurement reference, contract name, while box *Name and address of the Consultant* contained names of all proposed engineers without addresses, instead of *Key Expert: Contractor's Representative – Project Director*.

- Pursuant to Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Articles 12.1.11 and 14: *Tender validity period*, Article 15: *Tender security*, the attached security **DOES NOT contain all required elements in appropriate form.**

Reviewing the subject tender, it was established that tenderer had submitted Tender Security on required form and in the required amount of 211,100.00 Euro, with validity period thereof until 19 August 2016.

Tender Security validity period was until 19 August 2016, which is 14 days shorter than the period required by tender dossier (valid at least for sixty (60) days beyond the expiry of tender, and tender validity period is at least 90 days from the expiry date for submission of tenders, i.e. 150 days, or until 2 September 2016).

b) Final evaluation of tender

Upon the conducted check of administrative compliance with all conditions/criteria referred to in tender dossier, the Committee established that tender submitted by **GPD “Banković” d.o.o. Milentija Popovića bb, Crna Trava, reference number: 6276 dated 5 April 2016, is not compliant** with all conditions referred to in tender dossier, that it **has considerable lacks**, so the tender was rejected as **unacceptable**.

Taking into account that the tender was not compliant with administrative conditions/criteria referred to in tender dossier, technical compliance was not evaluated, computation errors were not checked and financial offer was not evaluated.

- 2) Joint tender submitted by **“GAT” d.o.o. Novi Sad, Bulevar oslobođenja 30/a, Novi Sad and “Deneza M Inženjering”, Vinogradska 110, Beograd**, tender reference number: **6277 dated 5 April 2016**, with the following tender data:

a) Evaluation of administrative compliance

Analyzing the tender and documents submitted thereto, the Committee established that the **tender is compliant** with administrative requirements/criteria stipulated in tender dossier,

Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, item 22.1: *Examination of the administrative compliance of tenders*, concluding the following:

- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 3: *Participation*, items (1) to (3), Article 11: *Content and presentation of tenders* and Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, the tender is complete;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 10: *Language of tenders*, the language of tender is appropriate;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, item 12.1.1. and Volume 1, Section 2: *Tender Form Appendix to Tender*, the Tender Form is adequately filled in;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by the tenderer*, item 12.1.1. and Volume 1, Section 2: *Tender Form Appendix to Tender*, Tenderer's Declaration is adequately filled in;
- In compliance with the Request for clarification, the Integrity Contract was signed;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to tenderers*, Article 3: *Participation*, the tenderer has fulfilled all mandatory conditions for qualification, i.e.:
 - Pursuant to Articles 3.1.1. and 3.2.1, the tenderer is registered at the competent authority;
 - Pursuant to Article 3.1.2. and 3.2.2, the tenderer has not been punished for listed criminal offences;
 - Pursuant to Articles 3.1.3. and 3.2.3, the tenderer has paid all due taxes and other liabilities in compliance with regulations of the Republic of Serbia;
 - Pursuant to Articles 3.1.5. and 3.2.5, the tenderer has fulfilled all requirements set forth in relevant legislation pertaining to occupational health and safety, employment and working conditions, environmental protection, and its securities that it holds the rights to intellectual property.
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Articles 12.1.11 and 14: *Tender Validity Period*, Article 15: *Tender Security Form*, the attached security contains all required elements in appropriate form.

b) Evaluation of selection criteria and of technical compliance

Further analysis of the tender and documentation attached thereto, the Committee members unanimously concluded that they needed additional information from the tenderer in order to evaluate selection criteria and technical compliance. To this end, the Committee sent a written request for clarification to the tenderer on 13 April 2016, requiring the following information:

- 1) For the reference project: ***Work on construction of student campus – Christian Collegium Europe in Novi Sad***, it was required to submit total value of works with specified currency, as well as complete final application for payment and relevant contract. The tenderer did not fully comply with this requirement since they did not submit the required contract, nor did they supply complete final application for payment (only the first and last page were supplied).
- 2) For the reference project: ***Construction works on school building of the Electric Engineering School in Novi Sad***, it was required to submit total value of works within the contractor's competence, i.e. competence of **GAT d.o.o. Novi Sad as leading member** of the joint tender/consortium, with specified currency, as well as complete

final application for payment and relevant contract. The tenderer did not fully comply with this requirement since they did not submit the required contract.

- 3) Key expert: Project Manager – Project Director: BSc in Civil Engineering: Zoran Đenadija; it was required to submit certificates for projects listed in the attached biography – Form 4.6.1.3, item 13. Professional experience, to prove experience in similar projects in the period of at least five years, certified and signed by the employer. The tenderer submitted all required documentation.
- 4) Key expert: Deputy Project Manager – BSc in Civil Engineering: Ivan Šćiban, taking into account that the attached biography – Form 4.6.1.3, item 13. Professional experience, did not clearly demonstrate experience in projects, it was required to supply a list of referent projects within which key expert worked for at least three years, as well as certificates for the listed projects, verified and signed by the employer. The tenderer did not fully comply with this requirement, since they did not supply verified and signed certificates from all employers from reference projects.

Tenderer replied to the request within specified deadline.

Analysing the tender and documentation attached thereto, as well as replies to the request for clarification dated on 20 April 2016, the Committee established that the **tender is compliant** with the following selection criteria and technical specifications referred to in tender dossier, i.e. Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, and Section 4: *Questionnaire*, concluding the following:

Fulfilment of selection criteria:

- In compliance with Article 12.2, item 1: *Economic and financial capacity*, the tenderer has had business turnover (defined as statement of completed and works in progress) of 10,000,000 Euros in total for the past three years (2012, 2013, 2014) from execution of construction, upgrade and reconstruction works, with leading partner meets more than 50% (fifty percent) of this requirement.
- In compliance with Article 12.2, item 5: *Financial capacities*, the tenderer demonstrated by means of a document issued by a commercial bank, that they have access to liquid funds and/or credit lines and/or other financial means, or that the aforementioned are available to them, where the amount of such funds are enough to meet the requirements related to cash flow in the project implementation period of at least 14 (fourteen) months, which is estimated (cash flow) at counter value of at least 1.5 million Euros.
- In compliance with Article 12.2, item 4: *Capacity related to mechanisation and equipment*, the tenderer possesses or has access to required mechanisation and equipment needed for execution of construction, artisan and all installation works on the building, as specified in relevant item of tender dossier.

Technical specifications

- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, item 12.1.4, the following has been provided:
 - General information about the tenderer (Volume 1, Section 4, Form 4.1);
 - Organisational scheme (Volume 1, Section 4, Form 4.2);
 - Power of attorney (Volume 1, Section 4, Form 4.3);
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, item 12.1.8, and Section 4, Form 4.6.3, the following has been provided:

- Work plan and programme with short description of main tasks, which shows the sequence and proposed schedule for realisation of tasks, with detailed works on the building and detailed description of working methods;
- Review of critical milestones with time schedule and duties of people responsible for contract implementation;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, item 12.1.8, and Section 4, Form 4.6.5, information about tenderers participating in joint tender/consortium (Form 4.6.5) has been provided;
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, item 12.1.8, and Section 4, Form 4.6.6, overview of quality control system which will be applied has been provided (Form 4.6.6).
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, item 12.1.8, and Section 4, Form 4.6.7, details about accommodation of the Engineer have been provided.
- In compliance with Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, item 12.1.8, and Section 4, Form 4.6.8, form for additional information has been attached.

Analysing the tender and documentation attached thereto, as well as replies to the request for clarification dated on 20 April 2016, the Committee established that the tender **IS NOT compliant** with the following selection criteria and technical specifications referred to in tender dossier, i.e. Volume 1, Section 1: *Instructions to Tenderers*, Article 12: *Information/documents to be supplied by tenderers*, and Section 4: *Questionnaire*, concluding the following:

Fulfilment of selection criteria:

- In compliance with Article 12.2 item 2: *Technical capacity*, tenderer did not prove that they fulfil condition referred to in second paragraph, more specifically, that leading partner of the group, GAT d.o.o. Novi Sad, has completed works as per types which will be executed on subject building, in construction, upgrade or reconstruction till full functionality of at least 1 (one) residential, commercial, commercial-residential, residential-commercial, public building (administration, education, healthcare, judiciary, military, police), excluding buildings like halls, hangars, covered areas, garages, of minimal gross area of 10,000m² of newly constructed, upgraded or reconstructed space, over the past five years (2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015). Since the conditions from the first paragraph of the same article was fulfilled through a group member, Deneza M Inženjering, which was corroborated with submitted proofs on experience in execution of works as leading contractor in 2 (two) projects of similar nature and/or complexity as proposed contract – construction, upgrade or reconstruction till full functionality of residential, commercial, commercial-residential, residential-commercial, public building (administration, education, healthcare, judiciary, military, police), excluding buildings like halls, hangars, covered areas, garages, the group of tenderers was obligated to prove fulfilment of conditions referred to in the second paragraph for the group of tenderers of GAT d.o.o. Novi Sad, which was not done.

Tenderer submitted alongside the tender Form 4.6.4 *Contractor's experience* filled in, listing 4 reference projects, as follows:

For GAT d.o.o. Novi Sad

- Works on construction of student campus – Christian Collegium Europe in Novi Sad
- Construction works on school building of the Electrical Engineering School in Novi Sad

For Deneza M Inženjering

- Scientific-technological park Zvezdara
- Residential building 2Đ, settlement of "Stepa Stepanović", Belgrade

The Committee, based on the information specified in the attached Forms 4.6.4 and 4.6.5, concluded that reference projects implemented by the consortium member Deneza M Inženjerig, meet the requirement referred to in Article 12.2. item 2, first paragraph.

The Committee, based on the information specified in the attached Form 4.6.4, and based on the clarifications supplied subsequently, found that projects implemented by leading member of the group, GAT doo Novi Sad, do not meet the requirement of Article 12.2. point 2, second paragraph. Specifically:

When it comes to **project *Works on construction of student campus – Christian Collegium Europe***, gross construction area of 11,353 m² of 59,607,753.60 RSD of value, the Committee required submission of the contract with the investor, as well as complete final application for payment due to obvious disproportion between the area of the building and value of works. The tenderer has supplied a letter instead of the required contract (without date and registering number) where they stated that GAT carried out works on 4th construction phase on the student campus of Christian Collegium in Novi Sad. Also, the tenderer has supplied only the first and last page of the required final application of payment instead of complete final application for payment, showing the amount of 59,409,607.20 RSD. Based on available information, the Committee could not determine whether the listed project fulfils conditions referred to in Article 12.2, item 2. The condition referred to in the first paragraph was not met because it turns out from the letter that GAT was a contractor on only one phase of the building construction of 11,353 m², but not the leading contractor in construction, upgrade or reconstruction till full functionality of residential, commercial, commercial-residential, residential-commercial, public building (administration, education, healthcare, judiciary, military, police), excluding buildings like halls, hangars, covered areas, garages (with the condition that such facility must at least cover 10,000m² of newly constructed, upgraded or reconstructed space), as required by the mentioned condition. Condition referred to in the second paragraph was not fulfilled either, since the available information clearly indicated that GAT d.o.o. did not executed complete works on the subject project related to construction of a building of at least 10,000m² of gross construction surface. The tenderer was obligated to supply reference project for GAT d.o.o., which would imply that this contractor executed complete works on the construction of building, because it was stated in Form 4.6.5 Information about joint tender/consortium, item 4.6.5.7 that GAT d.o.o. would execute all works stipulated in the relevant design.

When it comes to **project *Construction works on electrical engineering school building*** in Novi Sad, covering gross construction area of 10,000 m² (exact number), of 17,592,678.26 RSD of value, the Committee required from the tenderer to supply the contract with the investor and complete final application for payment. Instead of supplying the contract, the tenderer has supplied the Agreement on joint execution of public procurement for reconstruction of roof structure and replacement of roof cover on EES "Mihajlo Pupin" in Novi Sad, Futoška 17, between GAT, as leading member, and NPN Gradnja, as a member, which indicated that GAT was leading contractor of works, but it also clearly indicated that subject of the contract was reconstruction of roof structure and replacement of roof cover, no works on reconstruction of the entire building. Based on the available information, the Committee concluded that the listed project does not fulfil requirements referred to in Article 12.2, item 2. Condition from the first paragraph was not fulfilled because it was easy to conclude from the documents

that the project does not cover 10,000m² of reconstructed space as required, since reconstruction included only the roof. Condition from the second paragraph was not fulfilled either because available information clearly indicated that GAT d.o.o. Novi Sad did not execute all works at the subject project on construction, upgrade or reconstruction of building covering at least 10,000m² gross construction area. The tenderer was obligated to supply reference project for GAT d.o.o., which would imply that this contractor executed complete works on the construction of building, because it was stated in Form 4.6.5 Information about joint tender/consortium, item 4.6.5.7 that GAT d.o.o. and Deneza M Inženjerig would execute all works stipulated in the relevant design in proportion of 75% to 25% in favour of GAT d.o.o.

- In compliance with Article 12.2, item 3: *Professional capacity*, the tenderer nominated persons who will be hired for the project (Form 4.6.1.2) at all positions listed in the article. All listed persons are holders of valid required licences issued by the Serbian Chamber of Engineers. The tenderer also submitted biographies in accordance with Form 4.1.6.3 for all key experts, but failed to prove minimal experience in similar projects for key experts, as follows:
 - Key expert: Deputy Project Manager – BSc in Civil Engineering. The Committee was not able to clearly determine experience of Ivan Šćiban in similar projects from the supplied biography, so it was required from the tenderer to supply a list of referent projects within which key expert worked for at least three years with certificates for the listed projects, verified and signed by the employer. The tenderer supplied a list of projects, but verified and signed certificates from employers were supplied only for projects implemented since 2015 until present day, issued by GAT d.o.o. The tenderer did not supply certificates from employers for other listed projects.

c) Final evaluation of tender

Upon the implemented check of administrative compliance, as well as evaluation of selection criteria and technical compliance of the tender with all conditions/criteria referred to in tender dossier, the Committee concluded that tender submitted by **“GAT” d.o.o. Novi Sad, Bulevar oslobođenja 30/a, Novi Sad and “Deneza M Inženjerig”, Vinogradska 110, Beograd**, reference number: **6277 dated 5 April 2016, is not compliant** with all requirements defined in relevant tender dossier, that it **has considerable lacks**, so the tender was rejected as **unacceptable**.

Taking into account that the tender was compliant with administrative conditions/criteria referred to in subject tender dossier, but is **NOT** compliant with selection criteria and technical requirements and conditions specified in subject tender dossier, computation errors were not checked and financial offer was not evaluated.
