Regarding the request for additional clarification of the tender documents for the procurement no. N/R/02/16 - Performing construction, reconstruction and renovation works for the third group of schools within School Modernisation Programme – Component 3, we submit the following answer:

1. BIDDER'S QUESTION:

Page 10/73 of tender documents states:

“The bidder is obliged to visit the locations i.e schools to become familiar with the subject of the tender and submit within its bid confirmations on site visit issued by local municipalities. The cost of visiting the site shall be at the bidder's expense.”

Question 1.1. Considering that some lots have more locations (towns) where works are performed, does bidder need to submit Certificates on site visits for each location separately?

Question 1.2. Do the term "local municipality" refer to responsible person (director) i.e are certificates on site visits certified and signed by authorized representatives of the schools or by somebody else?

ANSWER:

The answer to the first question is yes. Bidder needs to submit Certificates on site visits for each location separately.

Certificates on site visits are signed and stamped by school director or coordinator appointed by the local municipality. Contact information for persons responsible for the site visits is available at website www.piu.rs.
