

CLARIFICATION NO. 2

**RHP-W5-AB-CW/IOP1-2018**

Based on the requests for additional clarifications regarding tender dossier for procurement: Execution of works on the construction of residential buildings, publication reference: **RHP-W5-AB-CW/IOP1-2018**, we provide the following clarifications:

**Question No. 1:**

(Filed under the number 3921 dated 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2018)

For fulfilling the conditions of technical capacity, as a tenderer's experience, is it sufficient to provide only a Certificate of Investor/Purchaser or a valid building permit or a decision on issuance of occupational permit or a commission record for technical inspection or record on qualitative inspection and acceptance of a reference building or a final payment certificate?

**Answer:**

Tender Documents, Volume 1, Section 1, Instructions to Tenderers, Item 12.2 under 3) Technical Capacity, under a) The Tenderer's experience, inter alia, provides that the Tenderer is obligated to provide the Investor's certificate for each and every constructed building on Form 4.6.4.2 and a valid building permit.

Volume 1 Section 4. Questionnaire, Form 4.6.4.1 List of contracts of similar nature and extent, footnote 6, provides that:

“In the event that the Tenderer cannot obtain the Investor's Certificate, the tenderer may attach the following evidence for the reference object:

- A decision on issuance of occupational permit for a reference building or a commission record for technical inspection of the reference building, or record on qualitative examination and acceptance of executed works on a reference building or a final payment certificate, from which it can doubtlessly be established that the tenderer had carried out works on the finished building. The stated evidence must be from the requested period.
- The abovementioned evidence must contain the information on the GRCE of the building.”

**Question No. 2:**

(Filed under the number 3921 dated 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2018)

Do you, as evidence of the tenderer's experience, accept the building for which the contract was signed before the requested period, and the completion of the works and final payment certificate was issued in the required period (2013)?

**Answer:**

See clarification no. 1 of the tender dossier, answer to question no.1.

**Question No. 3:**

(Filed under the number 3926 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> of July 2018)

May the tenderer submit a tender for the execution of one building from the Lot 3 of this notice?  
In particular, the building in Irig.

**Answer:**

No, the tenderer must submit a tender for the entire lot.
