6. Type of procurement procedure: International open procedure
7. Type of contract: Work Contract
8. Description of the services:
 In the framework of the implementation of the Regional Housing Programme in Serbia, the construction of the Multi Apartment Buildings is envisaged as one of the housing modalities (A1: Apartment Buildings) which is to be carried out in several implementation stages.
 The mentioned housing modality defines collective housing in the apartments on the new locations and refers to the refugees wishing to integrate in the local communities as the users.
 The scope of this project implies the construction of 250 apartments within I phase of social housing complex in Ovča, with respect to eight sub-project of Regional Housing Programme – Republic of Serbia’s Country Housing Project, in order to solve the housing needs of refugees on the territory of the City of Belgrade.

13. Selection criteria:

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a joint venture/consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the joint venture/consortium as a whole:

1. Economic and financial capacity of the candidate

a) Liquidity: That the tenderer did not have his account blocked in the last twelve (12) months prior to the date of publishing the invitation for tender submission.

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium: This condition is applied to all the members of the group of tenderers individually.

If the tender is submitted with the subcontractor: This condition is applied to all the subcontractors individually.

b) Bankruptcy and liquidation: No bankruptcy or liquidation proceedings have been initiated against the tenderer, or a previous bankruptcy proceeding.

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium: This condition is applied to all the members of the group of tenderers individually.

If the tender is submitted with the subcontractor: This condition is applied to all the subcontractors individually.

c) Average turnover: 18.000.000 euros for the last three years (2015, 2016, 2017).

Leading member of Joint Venture/Consortium must fulfil a minimum of 50% (fifty percent) of this condition.

d) Tenderer must demonstrate, by a document issued by a commercial bank, that it is available to him or has at his disposal a credit line and/or a revolving line and/or a multipurpose credit line for an equivalent of at least EUR 3 million EUR.

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium the Leading member must fulfil the stated condition.

2. Technical capacity

The Tenderer shall meet the following minimum criteria:

a) Experience in performing construction works: individually or as leading contractor on **two (2) facilities/group, block or complex of facilities** of similar nature and/or complexity as this contract – construction, upgrading or reconstruction of the existing building, until complete functionality of the facility in accordance with the classification

from the table below. One facility/group, complex of facilities must be a minimum of BUA (collectively underground and above ground parts of the building) 15,000m² (fifteen thousand square meters), and the other facility / group, block or complex of facilities must be a minimum BUA 10,000 m² (ten thousand square meters) of newly built, upgraded or reconstructed part of the building, **in the last five years (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018).**

Leading member of the Joint Venture/Consortium must fulfil the minimum condition for facility of BUA 15.000m².

b) Standards and certificates. Tenderer must hold the following certificates, in the field of construction:

- ISO 9001:2015 – Quality management system
- ISO 14001: 2015 - Environmental Management System
- ISO 50001: 2011 - Energy management system
- OHSAS 18001: 2007 - Occupational Health and Safety Management System

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium, technical capacity in respect of standards and certificates must be fulfilled by the Leading member of the Joint Venture/Consortium.

3. Personnel capacity

Tenderer must fulfil the minimum of the following criteria:

a) Total number of employees: Tenderer must have **at least 150** employed persons in the month preceding the tender opening date.

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium the Leading member must fulfil the minimum of 50% of this qualification criterion.

Evidence: Form 4.6.1.1 and Certificate/Excerpt from the Central Registry of compulsory social security with summarized review of all insured persons, for the month preceding the month of publishing the invitation for tender submission.

b) Tenderer must, in the month preceding the month of publishing the invitation for tender submission have employed the persons holding the following engineering licences:

- 2 civil engineers, licence 410 or 411 or 412
- 1 civil engineer, licence 413 or 414
- 1 architect, licence 400 or 401
- 1 electrical engineer, licence 450
- 1 electrical engineer, licence 453
- 1 mechanical engineer, licence 430

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium the Leading member must fulfil the minimum of 50% of this qualification criterion

Evidence: Certificate/Excerpt from the Central Registry of compulsory social security with summarized review of all insured persons, for the month preceding the month of publishing the invitation for tender submission, as well as the copies of the licences and copy of the certificate on licence validity.

c) Professional team for project realization: For the needs of realization of this contract the tenderer must, in his tender, show the following professional team for project realization.

*For non-resident tenderers, if the engaged persons do not have the required licenses at the time of the publishing the invitation for tender submission, the persons engaged must be in a position to obtain them before the entry into force of the Contract, the above licenses must be issued by the relevant institutions of the Republic of Serbia.

All mentioned persons shall be engaged full-time at the project realization, minimum 40 hours per week. All mentioned persons cannot be engaged on other projects and/or construction sites during the realization of the project. Same person cannot be engaged on multiple positions of Responsible contractor. Contractor's representative – Project Manager and Contractor's representative deputy – Project Manager Deputy can be the persons engaged on the position of Responsible contractor.

All engaged engineers must be experienced in working as responsible contractors – number of years of work experience at the position Responsible contractor in accordance with the set conditions.

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium, all members of Joint Venture/Consortium jointly fulfil the mentioned condition.

Professional team for project realization the tenderer submits in accordance with Form 4.6.1.2 and for each member of the team the tenderer must submit the Curriculum Vitae in accordance with Form 4.6.1.3., copy of the licence and copy of the certificate on licence validity. Contracting Authority pertains his right to request the additional evidence.

For Key experts along with the CVs, copies of licences and copies of certificates on licence validity, it is obligatory to submit the copies of certificates from employers or letters of recommendation, which prove the work experience of 10 or 5 years as *Responsible contractor*, which is stated in their CVs.

The Tenderer is obliged to ensure, in accordance with the laws and regulations of the Republic of Serbia, all workers and qualified persons required for the construction of the facility, regardless of the requirements of this Tender Documentation.

4. Technical capacity

a) **Mechanization and plant owned by the tenderer:** Tenderer must possess the following mechanization and plant, no less than:

Evidence: Provide appropriate proof of the ownership of the above mechanization and plant.

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium, technical capacity in respect of mechanization and plant must be filled by the Leading member of Joint tender/Consortium.

b) Mechanization and plant for the needs of project realization

Tenderer should possess or provide the access to mechanization and plant which must be fully prepared for the commencement of works, which is planned to be used during the execution of works. Tenderer must have a minimum of the following mechanization and plant for the execution of construction works, construction craft works and all installation works on the facility:

In case of Joint Venture/Consortium, technical capacity in respect of mechanization and plant for the needs of the realization of the project, the members of the Joint Venture/Consortium shall fulfil jointly.

Evidence: Tenderer is obliged to submit the Statement on owning/renting the mechanization and plant (Form 4.6.2) which must include the mechanization and plant listed in the clause 4 b) of these Instructions.

Tenderer is obliged to provide all mechanization and plant, necessary for the construction of the facility, regardless of the requests from the Tender Document.

14. Award criteria:

An award criterion to be used is lowest price.
