In the procurement procedure no. RHP-W9-CM-S/IOP3-2021, the subject of which is the procurement of 120 building material packages within the ninth subproject of the Regional Housing Programme in the Republic of Serbia, the Purchaser received the questions from the interested Bidder:

Question no. 1:

Please submit to us the additional information related to the public procurement RHP-W9-CM-S/IOP3-2021 including:

Whether the evidence for **Tenderer`s experience and Client`s certificates** confirming that the delivery of the building material has been completed, are to be submitted in original or copy, as is the case of submitting the copies of contracts and related delivery notes as requested evidence?

Answer:

Tender Document, in part Instructions to Tenderers, clause 3.13 sub clause 2 under a) foresees that the Bidder proves the fulfilment of the selection criteria by submitting the following evidence: signed from authorized person and stamped Tenderer`s Statement on Form 3 – Tenderer`s experience, as well as the contracts for the delivery of goods with signed delivery notes or with Client`s certificates, confirming that the delivery of construction materials specified in Form 3 – Tenderer`s experience has been successfully performed. In accordance with the mentioned clause the Contracting Authority reserves the right to request additional documentary evidence.

Tenderer can submit the original or copies of the requested Contracts or Client`s certificates, however, in accordance with the clause 3.14 Instructions to Tenderers, in case of submitting the copies of evidence, the Tenderer must submit the originals of the documents as well, should the Purchaser request so.

Question no. 2:


Can a copy of the certificate issued by the competent institution be submitted, as evidence that the **tenderer is not in the proceedings of bankruptcy or liquidation, as well as the previous bankruptcy proceeding?**

Answer:

Tender Document, in part Instructions to Tenderers, clause 3.13. sub clause 1. under b) Tenderer proves the fulfilment of the selection criteria that he is not in the proceedings of bankruptcy or liquidation, as well as the previous bankruptcy proceeding, by submitting a filled, signed by the authorized person and stamped Form 2 – Tenderer's declaration, as well as the Confirmation of a competent institution, issued upon the publishing of the Procurement Notice, that Tenderer is not in the proceedings of bankruptcy or liquidation, as well as the previous bankruptcy proceedings.

Tenderer can submit the original or copies of the requested evidence, however, in accordance with the clause 3.14 Instructions to Tenderers, in case of submitting the copies of evidence, the Tenderer must submit the originals of the documents as well, and should the Purchaser request so.
